Ohio law requires that anyone planning a digging project call at least 48 hours before digging. You will tell the operator what type of work you will be doing and they will notify affected local utilities companies. Within a few days, these folks will mark the approximate location of your underground lines, pipes and cables, so you can dig safely. 8-1-1 - it's the law.
