

Minutes of Special Council

February 26, 2007, at 6:30 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Larry Haver.

The Pledge of Allegiance was repeated by all present. Present were: Mayor, Larry Haver; Council members, Ed Foster, Ron Beverly, Amy Haver, Mick Pocratsky and Tom Haase; Solicitor, Troy Essex; Administrator, Kent Miller; and Clerk/Treasurer, Diane Collins. Ron Jones was absent.

Rick Weaver and Mike Atherine of Poggemyer Design Group (PDG) were present to answer questions about the wastewater treatment plant operations.

The council seemed to feel the new WWTP isn't handling enough water as the plant has flooded several times with 1 inch of rain fall. PDG was asked to explain how they came up with the size plant that they had us build, which they did. PDG said the plant was designed to handle 2.5 million gallons of water, which they say it is doing.

Phase II is the plan to handle the storm water run off. PDG explained that information given to the council previously explained the steps and the costs. Some council members voiced their concern at the cost for Phase II and denied that it was supposed to cost so much.

It was pointed out we will stress the plant until March 31, 2008. We have until December 31, 2008 to notify the EPA of how we plan to handle our storm water.

Foster wanted to know when we can start accepting septage. Beverly wanted to wait until the plant operates better.

Motion was made and seconded to adjourn at 8 p.m.
