The meeting was called to order by Mayor Larry Haver.

Administrator's Report: Miller reported the following:

General pick up starts April 8 and I hope it can finish in two days as sewer problems need attention as quickly as possible. We are not collecting leaves, grass, yard or garden debris, etc. Residents need to haul those materials to the lot.

Dig updates:

March 24 water main break at 10 p.m. Monday, done at 4 a.m. Tuesday.

April 4 sewer repairs along Handle Lane. This was postponed due to very heavy rains on April 3.

April 7 or 10 sewer dig on N. Main; depends on when Handle Lane gets done.

Reminded the public not to flush non-sanitary items down their toilets. The guys have been having pulling pumps quite a bit lately, especially at Defiance Avenue and Denan Dr. lift stations. Rags, diapers (adult and kid size), tampon holders, condoms, clothing, and other items go in the trash, not into the sewers. During the heavy rains on April 3 the guys were pulling Defiance Ave pumps constantly.

OEPA was here March 25 for a check on the plant and operations in general. It did not appear there were any major issues with things and a letter will be forthcoming. The Long Term Control Plan was discussed quite a bit but no time frame was given for a final answer. The fellow who came with Dana was to be meeting with his boss (and ultimate decision maker) last week but Miller has not heard anything back thus far. This is also tied to their approving our new NPDES permit as elements of the LTCP will be included in our permit. All together, the reps were in town from approximately 9:30 to 4:30.
